Perspectives in Public Affairs is seeking original, unpublished student, alumni or practitioner articles on current topics affecting public policy and public affairs. Research designs are not appropriate. *Perspectives* also welcomes non-research submissions of shorter length, such as literature reviews, book reviews, or notes and comments on relevant public administration and/or policy issues.

Deadline for submissions is January 30th, 2010.

Submission Guidelines

- Papers must follow the APA guidelines. Submissions that do not follow APA style will automatically be rejected. An APA “Crib Sheet” may be downloaded at <http://www.docstyles.com/archive/apacrib.pdf>.
- Submit papers as a Microsoft Word document by email with a completed submission form, which is available at <http://www.asu.edu/mpa/aboutjournal.htm>. Submissions should be no longer than 30 pages double-spaced (including citations and appendices).
- Please submit an abstract of no more than 300 words with the manuscript.
- Papers may also be mailed or hand delivered to Editor, c/o “Perspectives,” School of Public Affairs, 411 N. Central Avenue Suite 450, Mail Code 3720, Phoenix, AZ 85004-0687, along with a copy on electronic media. However, email is preferred.
